2025 APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

STAR GRANT PROGRAM GOALS

- To increase access to high-quality arts programs for Adams County citizens and visitors.
- To support arts activities in multiple disciplines in Adams County, traditionally an underserved region for the arts.
- To increase assistance to schools and local artists for arts residencies and activities.
- To encourage and support local decision-making in re-granting of county and municipal arts allocations.

GUIDELINES FOR ELIGIBILITY

Who is eligible?

Schools, non-profit arts organizations, non-profit organizations conducting arts events, and artists for commissions or for residencies are eligible to apply for a STAR Grant. (Note: letter of agreement from school or organization requesting or benefiting from artist services is required.)

- Project must be an arts activity that will directly benefit the public.
- Projects benefiting for-profit businesses are ineligible.
- Projects must be open to the public and take place in Adams County, or benefit an arts organization or artist(s) based in Adams County.
- Projects must occur between January 1, 2025, and December 31, 2025.
- Applicants must apply by November 8, 2024 (postmarked or delivered).
- An organization or school may request any amount; however, typical awards range from \$500-\$1,800.

FUNDING RESTRICTIONS

The following are not eligible for funding:

- Capital expenses (i.e., equipment)
- · Activities that have a religious purpose
- · Activities for which academic credit is given

- · Programs already completed
- Events not taking place in Adams County
- Cash awards or prizes
- Benefit or fundraising activities
- · Hospitality expenses (i.e. receptions, parties)
- Lobbying activities
- Competitions

CRITERIA GUIDELINES

A panel of five judges comprised of four community citizens and one ACAC Board Member will evaluate applications based upon the following criteria:

- Artistic quality of the project. Artistic merit of the project will be evaluated based on regional standards, project planning and design, realistic goals and activities, and qualifications of the artist(s). (15 points)
- Ability to carry out the project. Can the applicant successfully demonstrate completion of a project similar to the proposed project? What resources – monetary, people, supplies, space do you have available? (20 points)
 - □ Project Plan. Please provide a list of activities and a timeline for completion for your project. Indicate how prepared you are to begin, execute, and complete your project. Include a list of key participants (staff, artist(s), volunteers, etc.) as applicable, who will be responsible for executing this project. □ Budget. Please provide a detailed budget for your project, including any partners or additional funding sources that will contribute to the success of this project, if applicable.
- Community Served. Who will be served? Please indicate cultural/educational needs that will be served by this project. How many artists, students, teachers, members of the general public, and/or diverse populations to you anticipate to serve? (15 points)
